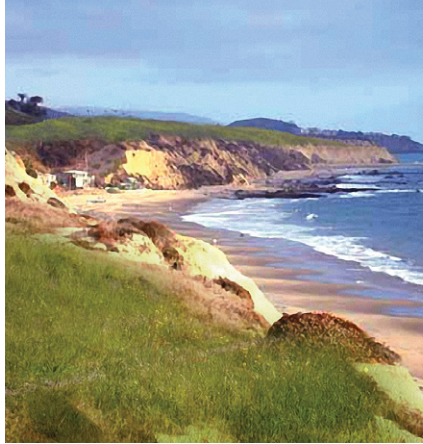
### CRYSTAL COVE NATIVE AMERICAN SUMMER CAMP
