This is the first year that Acjachemen descendent Jacque Nunez, an award winning storyteller and Educator of the Year for the state will partner with the San Onofre Foundation to bring a camp that is fun and includes local history. Perfect camp for families where siblings can learn and have fun together at the same camp.

Campers will receive a lesson from an artist which will include learning to draw the beautiful coast line and the ocean. Our program includes a visitation from several special guests and will include a lesson from a staff member from the Cooper Archeological Center.
